- **Session 2-** Connect student, family, and school; meet with school representative* to implement, support, and enhance the plan of accommodations for the classroom. (1 hr)
- **Session 3-** Work with the family and student to implement the new system for successful home routines. (1 hr)
- **Included Communications-** Included with the package is supplementary phone consultation to act as a liaison between Knippenberg, Patterson, Langley & Associates, parents, and schools. (1 hr)

Additional Support Services, after completion of initial session- (\$125 per hr)

- Supplementary sessions to provide additional support and ongoing communication between teachers and families, observe and improve upon student behavior in the classroom, or coaching on executive functioning
